Every ICAO State is required to publish an Integrated Aeronautical Information Package including an AIP, AIP Amendments, Supplements, Circulars and Checklists. European States also have the possibility of publishing the AIP as a specially formatted XML eAIP and sharing that information over the EAD system network.

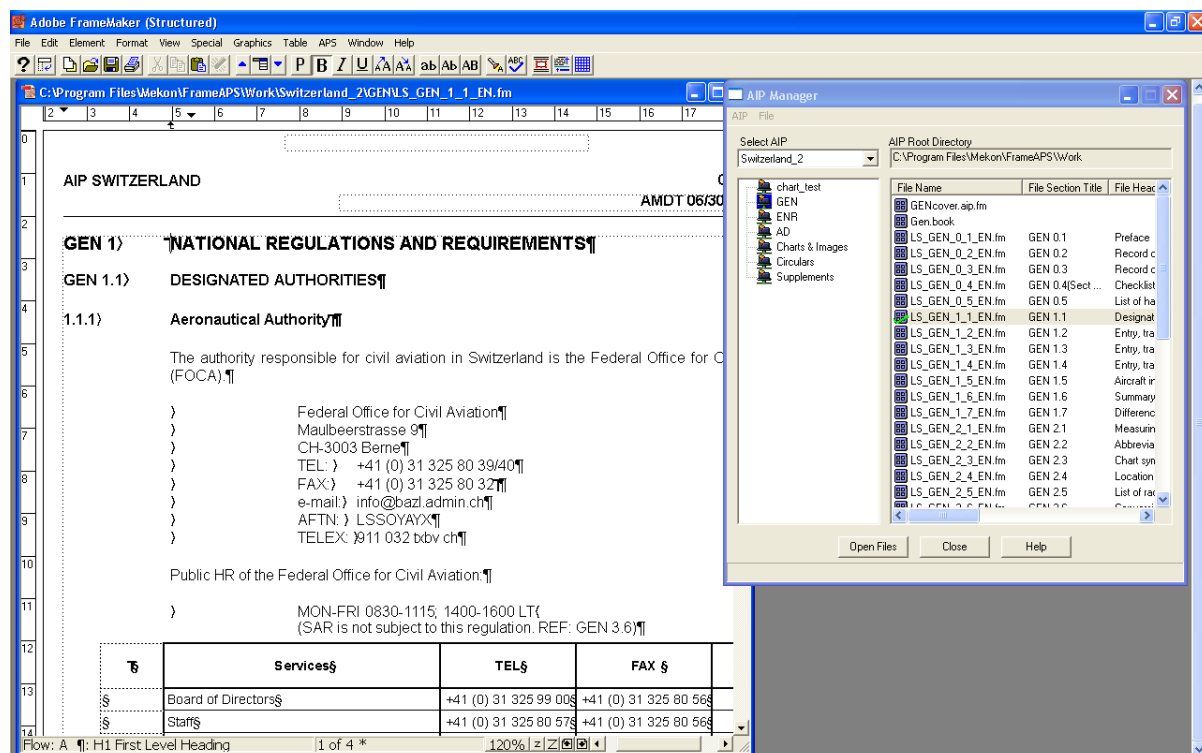

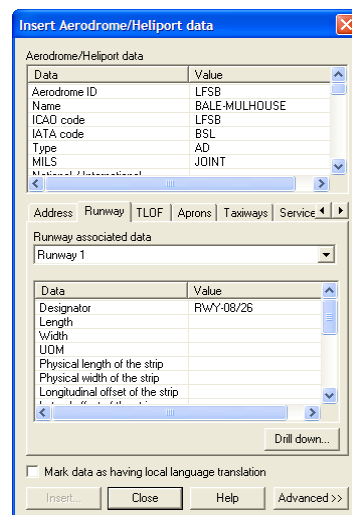
APS – Static Data Management

AIXM Static Data Support

Static Data for AIP creation is stored in an Oracle database and contains all available AIXM entities. The APS software accesses information stored in the database relating to Aerodromes, Waypoints, Nav aids, Obstacles and Airspaces etc and places them as either individual datalinks or within automatically generated AIP tables.

APS users

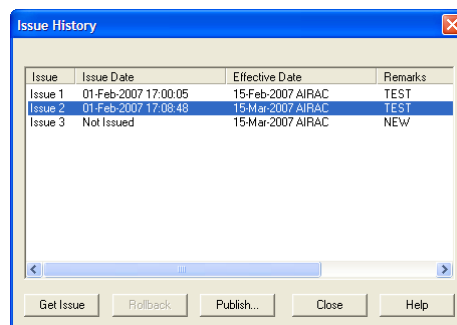
The APS system comes supplied with an AIXM Static Data Management interface which allows the user to manage and update Static Data in their own database. EAD Users connect to the Main SDO for datalink information.



APS - File Management Database

When operating in the APS environment, the files for the creation of AIPs, Supplements and AICs are held in the Oracle database and managed via an easy to use Graphical User Interface called the AIP Manager.
